What to Pack:

- Your dog's own food.
- Bedding or blankets that will fit in a crate.
- Bones or chews providing your dog is not aggressive with them.
- Collar with i.d. This should be a collar that can stay on your dog at all times.
- Vet records showing your dog current on DHLPP, Rabies, and Bordatella vaccines and showing negative fecal results within two months prior to their stay.
- All forms and waivers, completed and signed.
- Please do not bring your own toys unless it is something that you are o.k. with getting lost or destroyed.

Basic Policies:

Drop off and pick up times are from 9:00a.m. – 7:00p.m. Any dog picked up after 1:00p.m. will be charged for that day.

Right Paw Forward is run from a private residence. Please be respectful. Entry onto the premises will not be allowed without an appointment. This includes dropping off and picking up your dog.

All dogs will be brought inside to sleep in a crate at night or any time I am off of the property.

Any dog that becomes ill during their stay will need to be sent home. If they are in training, their training will resume at a future date. If you are out of town, they will need to go home with your emergency contact or be boarded at your vet.

If you will be out of the country or otherwise unavailable by phone, please leave a credit card on file at your vet's office should an emergency arise.

Because this is a private residence, I must adhere to regulations regarding noise. If your dog is a "repetitive" barker (a dog who barks continuously for 10 minutes of any 30 minute time frame), I will try various methods to keep them quiet and settled including time outs or more exercise. If none of these are effective, I may need to implement the use of an anti-barking collar. I will first try a citronella spray collar that sprays a quick burst of citronella spray near the dog's nose when he/she barks. The dog will not like the smell and will eventually figure out that it only happens when he/she is barking. If this is not effective, I will need to use an electric collar instead.

Payment is due in full at the time service is rendered. No payment plans may be arranged. Only checks or cash is accepted.
